Climate Protection & Nature

- Sankt Augustin aims to become climate-neutral by 2035.
- More trees, green spaces & green roofs – less concrete and gravel gardens.
- Expansion of renewable energy, heating networks and solar power.
- Stronger fire and civil protection to deal with climate impacts.

Modern Mobility

- Walking, cycling, buses and trains take priority over car traffic.
- High-speed cycle routes, safe school paths, and mobility hubs in all districts.
- 5-minute intervals on the light rail, better bus connections, and accessible stops.
- No new bypass roads – instead: noise protection and support for e-mobility.

Affordable Housing

- At least 30% of new housing developments should be social housing.
- City-owned land will be leased, not sold.
- Promotion of tenant solar power models and alternative living (e.g. multigenerational housing).

Social Justice & Education

- Continued expansion of childcare (Kitas), long-term goal: no fees.
- Renovation and digitalisation of schools, expansion of all-day programmes.
- Equal educational opportunities for all children and young people.

Diversity, Equality, Inclusion & Participation

- Inclusion for people with disabilities, queer people, and people with migrant backgrounds.
- More accessibility and easy-to-understand language in local government.
- Youth participation with their own budget and voting rights in relevant matters.

Strong Neighbourhoods & Economy

- Support for local centres, associations and cultural initiatives.
- Preservation of business and craft zones.
- Responsible municipal spending with focus on education, climate, and digitalisation.

Digital Future

- Accessible and transparent digital public services for everyone.
- Fibre-optic internet to every home, targeted 5G rollout.
- Free public Wi-Fi, supported by community-based initiatives like Fre
